CONDITIONS OF USE

Produce Full Drivers Licence

Client must produce a current Full Drivers Licence with contact details and phone number when uplifting the trailer chiller. That person or their nominated person, will be held responsible for the return of the trailer chiller at the end of the hire period. Drivers Licence number must be recorded.

Clean Chiller upon Return

The trailer chiller must be cleaned thoroughly prior to its return. If it is not up to an acceptable standard, **an additional \$50 cleaning fee may be imposed.** A floor sheet or cardboard should be placed on the floor to absorb any fallen blood product or waste when the chiller is being used.

Damage, Loss, or Electrical Issues during Hire Period

The client will be held responsible for any damage, any loss of items stored inside the chiller, any electrical issues that may occur to the chiller during the Hire Period. The Chiller Trailer should remain at the intended site location provided by the Hirer.

The client should have their own insurance to cover such damages, losses, or repairs otherwise, **the Bond will be forfeited to cover the repair costs.** Any repairs that exceed the Bond will be invoiced to the client for restitution.

Speed when towing Trailer

When driving with the trailer chiller, the speed limit on the open road is 90km/h. When you have a trailer attached to your vehicle your breaking time is affected due to the extra weight, so you should always allow for this.

Check your Trailer connections

Double-checking the connections and ensuring that the <u>trailer is safely hitched</u> before you drive away, is a good idea. Make sure any brake lights are working as well. As you do not have direct control of the tyres on the trailer, you should be incredibly careful to break lightly so that the trailer chiller does not skid, especially on gravel or dirt roads.
